Four ways to display your decorative dishware

Are you tired of keeping your beautiful dishes hidden away? Why not use them to decorate your home so you can enjoy them all year round? Here are some ways to turn your dishware into decor:

Exhibit them in a cabinet. If your dishes are family heirlooms or especially valuable, the best way to display them is behind glass. Choose a glass-fronted cabinet or hutch with shelves for showing off your collection.

Hang plates on the wall. Hang your most beautiful ornamental plates and other dishes on the wall using hooks or plate hangers, either individually or as part of a tasteful arrangement.

Use individual pieces as accents. Choose a few key dishes to use as decor in your living room, kitchen or bedrooms. Larger pieces like teapots and tureens can stand on their own on small tables or shelves while smaller dishes like teacups can be used to dress up bookcases and bathroom counters.

Repurpose them in your home. If you have dishes you're holding onto but no longer use, consider turning them into something new. Old teacups, plates, bowls and pitchers make great vases, planters, candleholders and soap dishes.

Another way to display your dishware?

Remove the doors of your kitchen cabinets so the shelving is exposed. This way, you can show off your best dishes while keeping them near the stove so you can easily use them whenever the occasion arises.

Kitchen cabinets that aren't white



For years, many kitchen renovations have focused on white cabinets. While popular, this choice can be uninspiring and often difficult to keep clean. Here are three ideas for your kitchen cabinets that will stand the test of time but have a bit more personality than white alone.

1. Blonde wood

Naturally pale wood combines the fresh, airy feel of white cabinets with the warm, homey feel of a cottage kitchen. Think light-coloured Nordic influences rather than the dark, lacquered stains from decades past.

2. Grey

Grey cabinets are great for kitchens because they're neutral but add the kind of visual interest that you can't get with white. No matter your style, there's a grey that will work for your kitchen. Go for an almost-white tone for an unexpected twist or try a charcoal hue for a more dramatic, elegant look.

3.Two-tone

There's no rule that says all cabinets have to be same. Double down on the grey trend by painting the lowers charcoal and the uppers a pale grey to make your ceilings look higher. Or experiment with colour by pairing a bold-hued island with natural wood cabinets.

Choosing one of these stylish options will add character to your kitchen in a way that white cabinets alone can't.

Why you need the 60-30-10 rule



If you're nervous about using colour in your home, try following the 60-30-10 rule. Designers use this concept to create well-balanced rooms. Simply pick three colours and use them in the following proportions:

1. Dominant colour: 60 per cent of your room is wall space and large pieces of furniture. Paint your walls a neutral colour or one that otherwise perfectly suits your space and tastes. Major furniture like the sofa or bed should feature the same hue.

2. Secondary colour: 30 per cent of any space is accent furniture, area rugs and textiles.

Pick a hue that complements your dominant colour and use it for these items.

3. Accent colour: 10 per cent of the room is decor, artwork and smaller items. Here is where you can really play with strong colours, textures and patterns that pop.

When following this rule, keep in mind that you don't have to use the same shades for your selected colours. For example, you might use navy on your walls, but choose a sky blue for your couch. As long as the shades for each pick fall within the same family, the result will be a pulled together room that's chic and polished.

How to create a breakfast nook in your home



A breakfast nook is a small, secluded dining space that's set apart from the rest of your kitchen or living room. It's usually reserved for lighter meals and has a more intimate and relaxed atmosphere than a dining room.

Even if your house doesn't have a built-in breakfast nook, you can create the feeling of one by putting a table and chairs in a small corner of your kitchen or living room that doesn't get much use. Not only will you gain a cosy niche for eating, chatting and reading, but you'll also be optimizing your living space by turning an awkward alcove into useable space. For maximal seating and legroom, think about installing benches or banquettes along the walls and using a pedestal table instead of a regular table and chairs.

To make your breakfast nook more inviting, include a hanging lamp over the table and add pillows to the benches or chairs for a bit of colour and comfort. Keep in mind that the best place for a breakfast nook is usually by a window: the view to the outdoors will prevent the space from feeling too cramped and keep your breakfast nook bathed in natural light during the day.

Accent ceilings: a great way to make any room stand out



When it comes to interior decorating, ceilings are rarely considered beyond the customary coat of white paint. But instead of ignoring your ceilings, think about highlighting them to make your rooms really stand out.

A jewel-toned ceiling in an otherwise neutral room will make the room look taller while adding a lively pop of colour.

Tin ceiling tiles (or plastic ones made to look like metal) add a touch of old school glamour to any space, especially a kitchen.

If you have a home with unconventional ceilings

that are vaulted or beamed, painting them will highlight the unique feature. Likewise, consider using wallpaper on a tray or recessed ceiling for greater impact.

Paint and wallpaper aren't the only things you can put on your accent ceiling. Hang a tapestry on the ceiling for a bohemian look or decorate a child's bedroom with polka dot decals for a modern take on the glow-in-the-dark stars you may have grown up with.
