3 climbing plants for your garden

Climbing plants lend a whimsical look to your property. They're also ideal for hiding fences and creating privacy in your yard. Here are three beautiful vines that will undoubtedly look great in your garden.

1. Climbing hydrangea (Hydrangea petiolaris)

Once this vine reaches maturity, which may take up to five years, depending on the climate, it produces delicate white flowers. Its dark green leaves turn yellow in the fall, and the bark turns red in the winter.

Climbing hydrangea can grow in shady areas, but will flower more in the sun.

2. Hops (Humulus lupulus)

Though ideal for covering a pergola or trellis, beer lovers will likely appreciate growing their own hops for entirely different reasons.

If you're planning on harvesting the cones to make your own home brew, make sure you choose a female plant.

Also, know that hops is part of the Cannabaceae family, meaning that this plant may give off an aroma similar to marijuana, its close cousin.

3. Boston ivy (Parthenocissus tricuspidata)

This beautiful vine looks great all year round, but will really turn heads in the fall. That's when its green leaves become a brilliant red. Despite its name, Boston ivy is actually native to Asia.

People growing indigenous plant gardens will want to opt for Virginia creeper (Parthenocissus quinquefolia) instead. It's native to most parts of North America and just as lovely as Boston ivy.

While vines can make a lovely addition to your landscaping, it's best to avoid letting creepers grow up your home's walls. They can cause damage to the structure and be difficult to remove. Consider placing a trellis in front of a wall instead.

How to preserve fresh berries



While having an abundance of fruit on hand is a happy problem to have, keeping your berries from going bad does present a challenge. Here are four great ways to preserve them

Make jam. To turn your berries into jam, all you need is a pot, your fruits, some sugar and pectin. Make certain you properly seal your jars to ensure the jam's safe to eat for up to a year. Homemade jams are perfect for spreading on toast or slathering over a bowl of ice cream.

Dehydrate them. Turn your oven into a dehydrator. Place berries on a baking sheet on the middle rack, and set your oven to the lowest heat possible. In a few hours, you'll have dried berries to snack on, mix into trail mix or even bake with.

Make freezer jam. Freezer jam is thinner than the cooked variety, but tastes more like fresh berries. First crush the berries and then mix them with sugar and no-cook pectin (available at most grocery stores). Spoon the mixture into small jars and freeze it.

Freeze them. Having frozen berries on hand is great for making smoothies, oatmeal and baked goods all year round. You can also try them thawed and topped with heavy cream and maple syrup for a decadent dessert. Before freezing, lay them out in a single layer in a freezer bag, making sure to remove as much air as possible.

These preserving methods will allow you to enjoy fresh berries long after the season has ended.



Start to finish: 20 minutes Servings: 8

Ingredients

- 500 grams ground pork
- 500 grams ground veal
- · 2 green onions, finely chopped
- 1 eaa
- 3 tablespoons breadcrumbs
- 3 tablespoons maple syrup
- 1 teaspoon garlic salt
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Wood skewers, soaked in water for 30 minutes

Directions

- 1. In a bowl, thoroughly mix all ingredients.
- 2. Divide the mixture into 8 portions. Shape each portion into a tube around one of the skewers.
- 3. Preheat the barbecue to medium heat.
- Grill the kefta for about 2 minutes on each side, until browned.
- 5. Transfer to top grill to finish cooking. Serve either wrapped in pita bread with a yogurt dressing or on top of a salad.

If you don't have wooden skewers on hand, you can form the mixture into burger patties instead!

How to use barbeque brushes safely

If you use a wire-bristled brush to clean your barbecue, be aware of the dangers it can pose. The tiny wires can get dislodged and end up in your food. If ingested, they can cause serious medical problems. Health Canada identified at least nine cases of this type of injury in 2017 alone.

While it's not a common occurrence, there are steps you can take to protect yourself and your family members from being injured by wire bristles. For starters, you should buy a new, high-quality

barbecue brush every year and be sure to throw out the old one so it doesn't accidently get used.

Additionally, there are brushes made with nylon bristles, and others that are made of tightly coiled steel. Another option is to use a wooden scraper to clean your grill. You can even simply scrub the cooking grates with a ball of crumpled up aluminum foil or an oiled onion cut in half.

This summer, protect your family members and guests by making sure your grill brush is in good condition and doesn't send anyone to the hospital.

 Perform a safety check by using pliers to try to pry a bristle out. If it dislodges easily, replace the brush.

I've taken possession of my new home, but pictures, sold price, and its address are still on the listing agent's website, advertised as sold. I want them to take down the pictures and address. Can I make them?

It depends if the information they post on their website is personal information or not. Personal information is defined in the Personal Information Protection Act as information about an identifiable individual. This means that if the information could identify you, it's personal information, and someone needs your consent to use it.

In real estate, a picture of the exterior of your house, information about its neighbourhood, and even the address are likely not personal information. All of that information is readily available on sites such as Google Maps, but the law is less clear when this information is combined with a statement that the property was just sold, and at a certain price.

Though it has not been tested in court yet, this combination of information could be considered personal information. It's because of legal grey areas like this that RECA recommends real estate professionals get written consent from buyers if they want to continue advertising a sold listing after possession takes place. Once possession takes place, the seller is no longer the person who provides that consent; it's the new owner – the buyer.

If there is any doubt about whether or not there is personal information in an advertisement, real estate professionals should try to get written consent from the property owner before advertising, or exclude the information in the ad.

If you are concerned that a real estate professional's website contains your personal information through posting a sold listing, talk to the real estate professional in question. There are strict confidentiality rules for real estate professionals, and privacy legislation may apply too. You can also bring the issue to the real estate agent's broker.

You may not be able to make a real estate professional take an ad down if it doesn't contain your personal information, but if you're still uncomfortable with it because you believe it shares too much about your property, a true professional should be open to hearing your concerns and working with you to address them.

- 250 grams cream cheese, softened
- 2/3 cup sweetened condensed milk
- 1-1/2 cup heavy cream
- 1-1/2 tablespoon vanilla extract

- 1. In a pot, combine raspberries and sugar and cook over low heat until the raspberries release their juice.
- 2. Add cornstarch and continue to simmer for another 2 minutes, or until the mixture has thickened.
- Using a stand mixer, beat the cream cheese until smooth and creamy. Add the sweetened condensed milk, cream and vanilla extract slowly. Continue to mix until the ingredients are well combined.
- 4. Pour about one-third of the cream mixture into a bread pan and top with half the raspberry mixture. Repeat with the remaining cream and berries, ending with a layer of cream. With a butter knife, distribute raspberry mixture using circular motions to create swirls.
- 5. Cover with aluminum foil and freeze for at least 4 hours. Remove from freezer 20 minutes before serving.
